

Summer Enrichment Programs

Purpose:

- To continue to motivate excited learners and keep their academic skills sharpened throughout the summer.
- Challenge students to explore new concepts and acquire new skills.
- Build an effective multi-age team who will benefit from the interaction and collaboration of academically minded peers.
- To send students back to school in the fall excited about learning and ready for more.

Dates and Times: This year, there will be two opportunities for summer enrichment.

- 1) The first session is a 5-class enrichment program for grades 3-5. These classes will be similar in format to last summer's enrichment program. Classes will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays in July from 11:30 AM to 3:30 PM. The dates for this session are:
****July 7, 12, 14, 19, and 21****
- 2) A second, week-long session will be held from July 26th through 30th for grades K-5. These enrichment classes will be held Monday through Friday from 10:00 AM to 4 PM.

Location: The Kolodziej Classroom and Yard – *102 Horseshoe (Pitchfork, Mt. CB)
*Please note the location change from last year. We may utilize different locations in town and on the mountain but we will let you know in advance of any changes.

Materials: All materials will be provided, including novels and consumables.

Lunch/Snack: Students will need to bring a sack lunch and an afternoon snack.

Cost:

- 1) \$200 for the first session of the summer program – 5 days of classes (\$40 per day)
- 2) \$300 for the second, week-long program – 5 days of classes (\$60 per day)

For both programs, we ask that you commit to at least 4 out of the 5 days in order to hold your child's spot in the program.

Capacity:

- 1) Space in the first program is limited to 10 students who are currently in 3rd-5th grades.
- 2) Space in the week-long program is limited to 10 students in grades 3rd-5th and 20 students in grades K-2nd. We will consider students who are currently in 6th grade on a case-by-case basis (the most important factor in consideration is that they don't mind participating with younger kids).

For most activities, students will be grouped with other children of similar grade-level and age. First come, first serve.

Please fill out the attached application and return it via e-mail or drop it off at the school by April 1st. A deposit of ½ of the total is due by May 1st to hold your child's spot.

Summer Enrichment Class will cover the academic areas of reading, writing, math, science, art, and health.

Reading/Writing

- Book club based novel study with group discussion, journaling, and written responses to literature
- Creative writing
- Specific reading and writing skills lessons and activities

Math

- Puzzles/Brain Teasers
- Challenging skills work
- Independent studies

Science

- Experiments and discovery learning
- Science project stations
- Independent studies, Field-trips

Art

- Integration of art into all content areas
- Exploration of different media for projects
- Art appreciation

Health/Outdoor Play

- Exercise through group activities and games
- Healthy diet and lifestyle will be reinforced through examples
